Slade Trammell, Pianist, Performs at UT

The University of Tennessee School of Music is pleased to present Graduate Teaching Assistant, **Slade Trammell** in his Master's Degree recital in piano performance on Friday, July 10 at 6:00 p.m. in the U.T. Music Hall.

Trammel, who has studied piano under UT's Dr. David Brunell since 2001, won the American Philharmonic Young Artist Award in 2008 and was selected to perform Tchaikovsky's Piano Concerto No.1 with the American Philharmonic Orchestra in Santa Rosa, California in May, 2009.

Performances have taken him around the United States, and in August 2008 he made his European debut with recitals in Salzburg and Steyr, Austria.

Past awards have included the University of Tennessee National Piano Scholarship Competition, the UT Celebration of Excellence Competition, and a Music Study Club Prize. He has also been accepted for private coaching by legendary concert pianist Earl Wild.
